CRITERIA

The Holocaust and Human Rights Center of Maine seeks nominations for the 2019 Gerda Haas Award for Excellence in Human Rights Education and Leadership. Nominees should have demonstrated excellence in the fields of human rights education and leadership. The following criteria will be considered by the committee when determining the recipient of the 2019 Gerda Haas Award:

Impact: How has the nominee helped, reached, touched people, in his or her work?"

Need: What were the needs of the people who were helped? Were they displaced, homeless, starving, sick? Or simply in need of education, awareness, and understanding?

Longevity: How long has the nominee been performing his or her humanitarian work?

Reach: Has the effort been local, regional, or global?

Maine: How has the nominee's work affected Maine communities?

HHRC's strategic goals: How do the nominee's priorities and/or actions in the community align with the mission and goals of the HHRC?

For nominees to be considered, completed award nominations must be received by the Holocaust and Human Rights Center of Maine by April 15, 2019.
