## Lawrence Alan Spiegel Remembrance Scholarship

The Spiegel Scholarship (\$1000) is awarded annually to the graduating high school senior who authors the prize-winning original essay on the following question:

*Why is it important that the remembrance, history, and lessons of the Holocaust be passed to a new generation?*

### GUIDELINES

Any high school senior or home schooler who resides in Maine, and who has been accepted at any accredited Title IV-eligible college or technical school, is eligible for the scholarship.

Student essays, not to exceed four typed pages, will be read by a panel of judges to be nominated by the HHRC Education Committee.

Essays, along with the completed application form, may be submitted after January 1, and must be received no later than **April 15, 2019**.

The scholarship will be announced in May, and funds will be disbursed after the winning student successfully completes the first semester.
